

- Co-creation governance model with students and staff










Impact of COVID-19





More than 96% think they would have been better prepared if their European University had been fully operational




More than 60% consider that being part of a European University has put them in a stronger position



96% of the institutions think they would have been better prepared to face this pandemic:

- A fully-functional digital EU inter-university campus with a challenged based approach
- Fully working infrastructure, tested methodology for joint blended courses and recognition mechanisms for students and staff.
- Short learning courses leading to micro-credentials, to equip the European workforce with skills that are essential in the context of the recovery, allowing anyone to up-skill and re-skill at any stage of their career.
